A decision will be made by 6.a.m. for day classes and by 3 p.m. for evening classes.

Classes Delayed means classes will not meet during the time of the delay. Students and faculty will resume a regular schedule at the time announced that the College will open.

(Example: In the case of a two-hour delay, ALL classes and activities will resume at 10 a.m.)

Classes Canceled means there are no classes for students. Employees are expected to report to work or take annual leave.

College Closed means neither students nor employees are expected to report to the College.

The College will determine how canceled classes will make up the work. Students, faculty and staff must assume responsibility for deciding if weather conditions are too hazardous to permit safe driving on public roads. Safety and good judgment are required in each individual case.
