



Student Right-to-Know Statistics

The Student-Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act (P.L. 101-542) mandates that all institutions participating in Title IV or HEA programs disclose graduation and transfer-out rates to current and prospective students. In compliance, Mitchell Community College (MCC) followed 302 first-time, full-time college students who enrolled in one of the Colleges' degree, diploma or certificate programs in Fall 2007. Twenty-one percent of these students graduated; 21% transferred to another institution prior to graduation; and 15% are still enrolled at MCC. In sum, 57% of the first-time, full-time college students entering MCC in Fall 2007 have graduated or continued their studies at MCC or at another public or private university in the United States as of Fall 2010.
