Graduation and Transfer-Out Rates

The Student-Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act (P.L. 101-542) mandates that all institutions participating in Title IV or HEA programs disclose graduation and transfer-out rates to current and prospective students.

In compliance, Mitchell Community College followed 381 first-time, full-time college students who enrolled in a degree, diploma or certificate programs in fall 2013. Of that group of students:

24%	Graduated
20%	Transferred to another institution prior to graduation
8.67%	Are still enrolled at Mitchell

In total, 52.67% of the fall 2013 first-time, full-time college student cohort have either graduated or continued their studies at the College or another public or private U.S. institution as of fall 2016.

Mitchell Community College tracked 319 first-time, full-time college students enrolled in Fall 2015 and determined that 57 percent of these students either returned to the College in Fall 2016 or completed a program. The College also tracked 155 first-time, part-time college students enrolled in Fall 2015 and determined that 37 percent of these students had either returned to the College in Fall 2016 or completed a program.
