An appointment will be scheduled for the prospective student to complete a *Music Theory Placement Test* and an audition. The *Music Theory Placement Test* will include fundamental music theory concepts such as notational reading, rhythms, scales, key signatures, and time signatures. Music Fundamentals (MUS 111) is available for students who desire an introduction or a review of these concepts before progressing to Music Theory I (MUS 121).

The audition is facilitated by the appropriate Applied Music faculty member. This one-on-one audition provides information for the faculty member in regard to curriculum planning for each individual student.

The initial appointment will also serve as an advising opportunity for first semester planning. Additional discussion will involve transfer institutions and career paths.
