



Safety Protocols for Re-Entry to Classes for Fall 2020

*****Updated August 25, 2020*****

Classroom Protocols

- Before entering the classroom, all students must complete a pre-survey to be confirmed by instructor.
- Masks are required in all classrooms (*see Mask Requirement communication dated June 25, 2020*). A student cannot enter a classroom without wearing a mask. One cloth mask will be provided by the College. Individuals are welcome to bring their own masks.
- Social distancing of 6 feet is mandatory wherever possible.
- At the conclusion of each class, wiping down of desks with provided sanitation wipes will be required by students.

Mask Distribution for Students

- At the beginning of the semester, students who are arriving on campus will be provided a disposable mask unless they have their own to wear.
- On the first day of class, each student will be given a cloth mask unless they have their own to wear. This cloth mask can be laundered and worn on campus for the entire semester.

Exceptions

- A student may remove a mask at the request of campus security and/or law enforcement.
- Students may remove a mask when eating or drinking.
