



Financial Aid Newsletter Summer Registration 2022

IS THERE A FINANCIAL AID DEADLINE FOR SUMMER REGISTRATION? YES! To guarantee the use of financial aid for Summer registration, you must have submitted all documentation as requested to the Financial Aid Office by **April 4, 2022**. Processing of award letters will continue on a regular basis for students completing their files. **However, eligible students who do not receive an e-mail notification to their Mitchell account about viewing their award on WebAdvisor by May 16, 2022 should plan to pay their tuition/fees to secure their SUMMER registration class schedule.**

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR YEAR-ROUND PELL SUMMER TERM? It depends ... three examples follow:

1. **Student A** was enrolled full-time for the Fall and Spring semesters and received 2 full Pell disbursements. **Student A** could be eligible to receive Pell Grant in SUMMER, IF enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours.
2. **Student B** was enrolled full-time for the Fall and Spring semesters but only enrolls for 4 credit hours during the summer semester. **Student B** is not enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits and not eligible for Pell Grant.
3. **Student C** was enrolled less than full-time for either Fall or Spring semesters and has Pell Grant remaining to award for Summer based on eligibility and credit hours enrolled.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PAY WITH FINANCIAL AID? If you **RECEIVE an e-mail notification about your 2021-2022 Award Letter** from the Financial Aid Office at Mitchell Community College **before May 16, 2022**, your tuition and fees will automatically be paid by financial aid with **NO ACTION** required on your part.

WHEN CAN I USE FINANCIAL AID TO CHARGE AT THE BOOKSTORE? You may charge books and supplies **May 16 – May 19, 2022 for classes starting May 17, 2022**. For classes starting June 1, 2022 and June 30, 2022 books can be charged to financial aid June 1 through June 9, 2022. We encourage you to attend class before purchasing your textbooks. This helps to reduce the number of returns and refunds. Please limit the number of trips you make to the Bookstore to two (2). You may charge one item of clothing **IF** you are registered for a PE class only. You may also charge one (1) book bag, if needed. **A picture ID and a printed schedule of classes is needed to make purchases.**

WHEN WILL MY FINANCIAL AID CHECK BE AVAILABLE? The remaining balance, after tuition, fees and Bookstore charges have been deducted, **will be mailed on June 17, 2022 from Financial Services to the address listed with the Admissions Office, NOT the address you listed on your FAFSA.** Remember you **MUST** keep your address current with the Admissions Office. A check **will not be re-issued** until Mitchell Community College has received the returned check due to an insufficient address.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Courses must be required for your current program of study to be covered by financial aid.
- You must be attending all classes through the 60% point of each course (Example: the 60% point for an 8-week class is July 6th) to be entitled to your Financial Aid. If you totally withdraw or your instructor withdraws you from all your classes before this date, you may be responsible for the repayment of Pell Grant and/or FSEOG under R2T4. If you are a "No Show" in class(es), your financial aid will be calculated based on the number of hours you are currently attending. Tuition charges are due for No Shows.
- You are not eligible to receive financial aid from more than one institution during the same semester within the same academic year.
- If you register for short session classes with a start date later than May 17, your financial aid will be calculated based on the number of hours you are currently attending. Any remaining financial aid for the short session class(es) may be awarded once your attendance in the class is confirmed.
