Comments:

Mitchell Community College values its employees and recognizes their need for a safe and healthy work environment. This policy applies to anyone who is representing or conducting business for the College or engaged in activities as a Mitchell student or College program participant.

All Mitchell Community College students, employees and visitors must follow a standard of conduct that the unlawful manufacture, distribution, possession, or use of a controlled substance is prohibited on any campus premises, or as part of any off-campus, official College-related activity.

This policy applies during all working hours, while on call, while on College property, while attending College-sponsored events, and/or while driving any vehicle owned by the College.

As a condition of employment, the College requires all employees to abide by this policy. Each year employees are required to sign the "Alcohol and Drug Free Workplace Acknowledgement" form.
